Course Introduction

Europe Foreign Direct Investment Studies

Course objectives and requirements

This is a 54-hour core course for all students in Centre for European Studies, with its aim to introduce the basic knowledge and basic theories of Europe Foreign Direct Investment (FDI), such as Transaction Costs Theory, relative technical advantages and industrial location transfer and etc. In addition, students may have the opportunity to learn FDI in Europe and do dummy practice as well.

Requirements for applicants

- Doctor/Master in Economics/ Finance from a leading overseas institute.

- With at least two or three-year teaching experiences or equivalent working experiences in a university.
- To be able to teach in fluent English.
- To be able to identify the concepts and theories of Economics/Finance.?
- To be familiar with the latest economic topics.
- To be familiar with policies, laws and cultures integrated into the Economics/Finance.
- To be able to analyze the world-wide economic/financial phenomenon.
